


What do we see as the loopholes?

Planning at the sub-national level of CCA by utilizing a cross-sector approach helps bring all ministries to the table.

This fosters agreement building and cross-sector collaboration.



#### **CC Planning Timeframes**

**Short Term**: To cope with recently experienced CC impacts.

**Medium Term**: to adapt based on locally foreseen extrapolation of past CC impacts.

**Long Term**: To adapt based on downscaled CC change scenarios
