

- National Adaptation Plans Country-driven, continuous, and multistakeholder process that integrates climate change into the existing national mechanisms
- Readiness for Green Climate Fund
  - For handling larger volume of external financing
  - Directly access

# Is the existing adaptation/development financing architecture benign to the reality capacity constraints?

- Many government staff are project-funded and many sectoral Ministries are severely under-staffed
- Adaptation finance needs to be used on "additionality"
  Derived from the notion that adaptation finance should be "new and additional"
- Under the existing architecture of adaptation (and development) financing, public budget support is extremely difficult






### Internal migration trends





#### Tonga (1986-1996)






#### Second question
