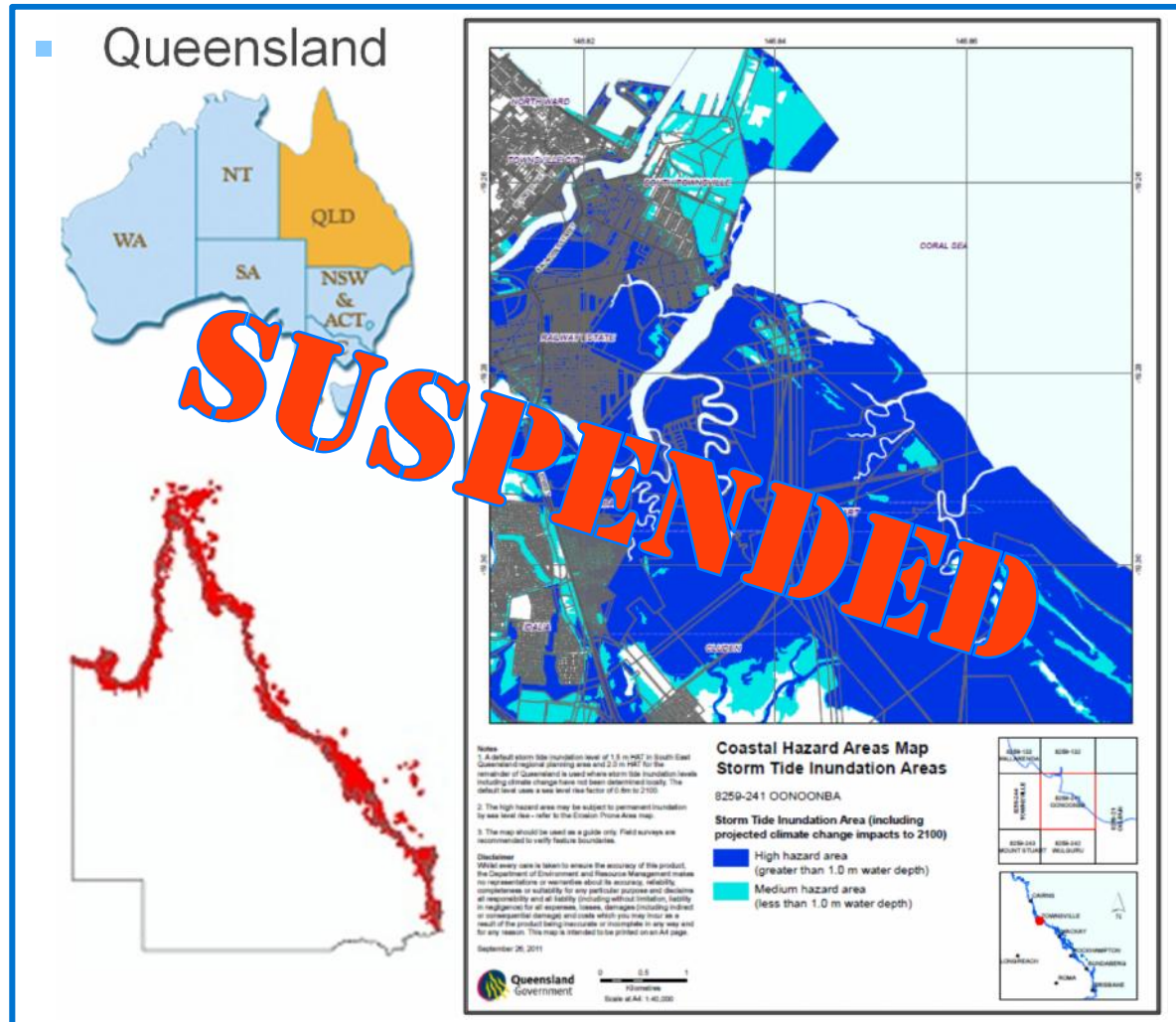

 2. Provide legal and institutional frameworks that facilitate climate change adaptation planning and support resilience
 3. Provide decision making frameworks that give an understanding of climate legal risk
 4. Develop and implement strategies for dealing with climate related legal obligations.
