

Purpose of Session IV: Group Activity

- Group Activity for mapping of key features for mainstreaming and integrating climate change adaptation.
- To provide an opportunity to collectively explore the needs and challenges for mainstreaming and integrating climate change adaptation in the Asia-Pacific region.
- In order to achieve:
 - 1. Mapping of necessary systems, functions and mechanisms for effective national-level mainstreaming; and
 - 2. Identifying future scenarios for improved mainstreaming considering how to enhance overall coordination and integration.

Process

- Group discussions will consider 6 aspects related to the mainstreaming and integration of climate change adaptation:
 - Policy Integration into National Planning and Agenda
 - Coordination Mechanisms for Cross-Agency Cooperation
 - Budgetary Alignment Mechanisms
 - Support Mechanisms for Vertical Integration and Implementation
 - Sectoral Integration and Prioritisation
 - Local-level Integration and Implementation
- Discussions will consider two dimensions on mainstreaming and integration:
 - Current status → strengths and weaknesses
 - Future Scenarios
 opportunities for strengthening and innovative approaches for application



Discussion Questions

Level 1: Current Status

- What are the current strengths related to the various aspects for mainstreaming and integration?
- What are current needs and gaps for achieving effective mainstreaming?

Level 2: Future Scenarios

- What are opportunities for improvement and potential innovations?
- What is the key priority or goal for each of the six aspects for achieving effective mainstreaming and integration?
- What are specific mechanisms and approaches that may be employed at each level to improve overall mainstreaming and integration?

Additional Discussion

- How can we better streamline systematic and holistic processes for Adaptation mainstreaming and integration?
- Are there specific capacity building approaches that should be employed for achieving this future scenario?



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
