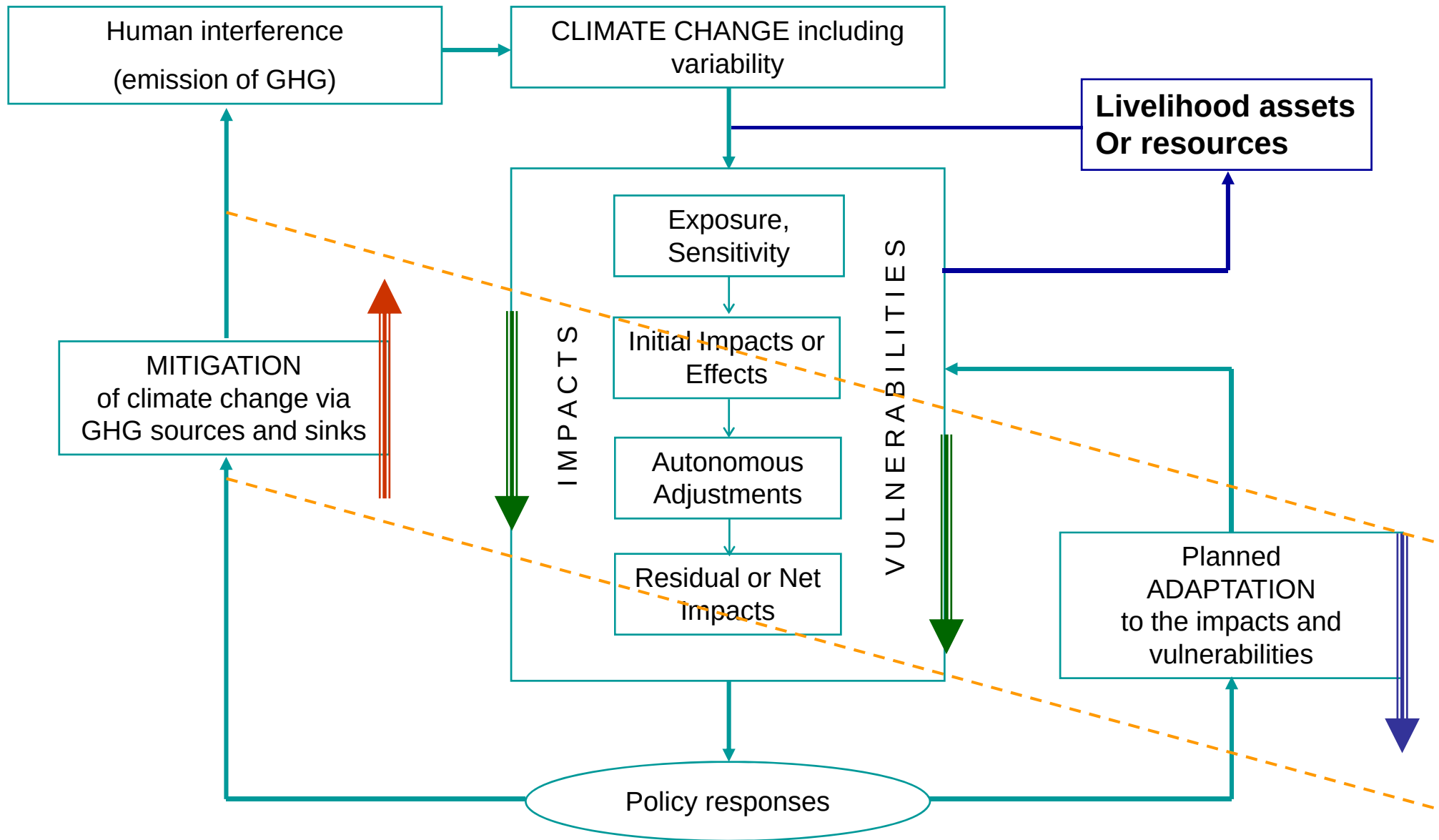

Why Adaptation May Fail?

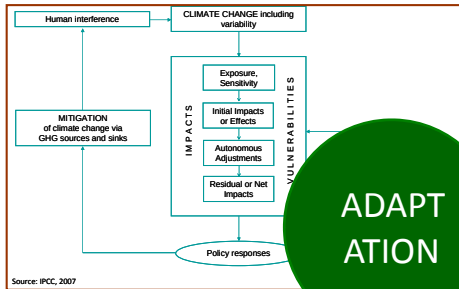
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Mitigation and Adaptation: Inter-linkages

ADAPTATION

Adaptation objectives

Maintaining functional property of assets and ensuring outputs

Constraints: factors that make planning and implement adaptation actions harder

Adaptation Options/Actions

Opportunities: factors that make implement of adaptation and achieve adaptation objectives easier

Option universe
(High to Low)
(Local to global)

Capacity and Resources (Constraint)

Types of actors
(local to global)

Limit to adaptation: no adaptation options exist

- Biophysical
- Technological
- Economic and finance
- Social and cultural
- Institutional and policies

Awareness, learning, innovation etc.

Levels
(local to global)

Hierarchy of limits
