- In 2003, became **ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability** with a broader mandate to address sustainability issues

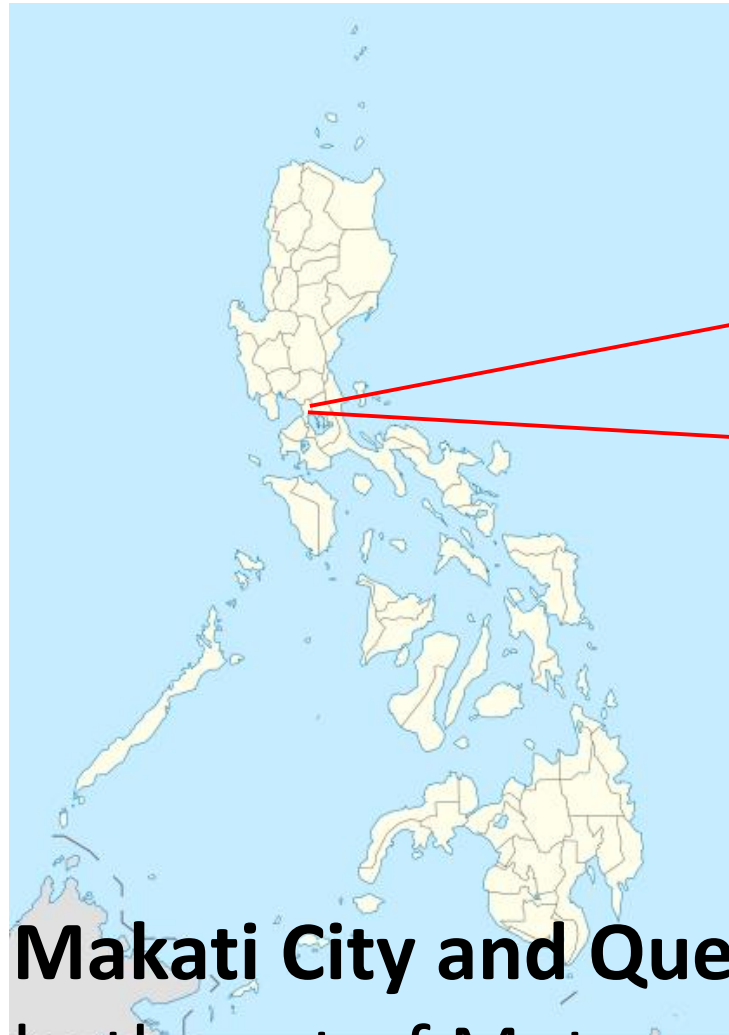


Entry Point # 1: ACCCRN

- ICLEI SEAS is currently implementing the **Asian Cities Climate Change Resilience Network (ACCCRN)** – www.acccrn.org
 - with support from the Rockefeller Foundation
 - will run until 2015
 - consists of a tested guide and toolkit to help cities develop local climate change resilience strategies

- Forming a Stakeholder Group – stakeholder analysis tools
- Participatory Vulnerability Assessment
- Tapping technical expertise of academe in terms of:
 - Establishing baseline climate information
 - Conducting hands-on training on land use models

- ICLEI currently serves as sub-regional node for Southeast Asia
- Create platforms for scaling up best practices on watershed management vis-à-vis CCA in the region
- Formulation of knowledge products
 - policy brief, case study
