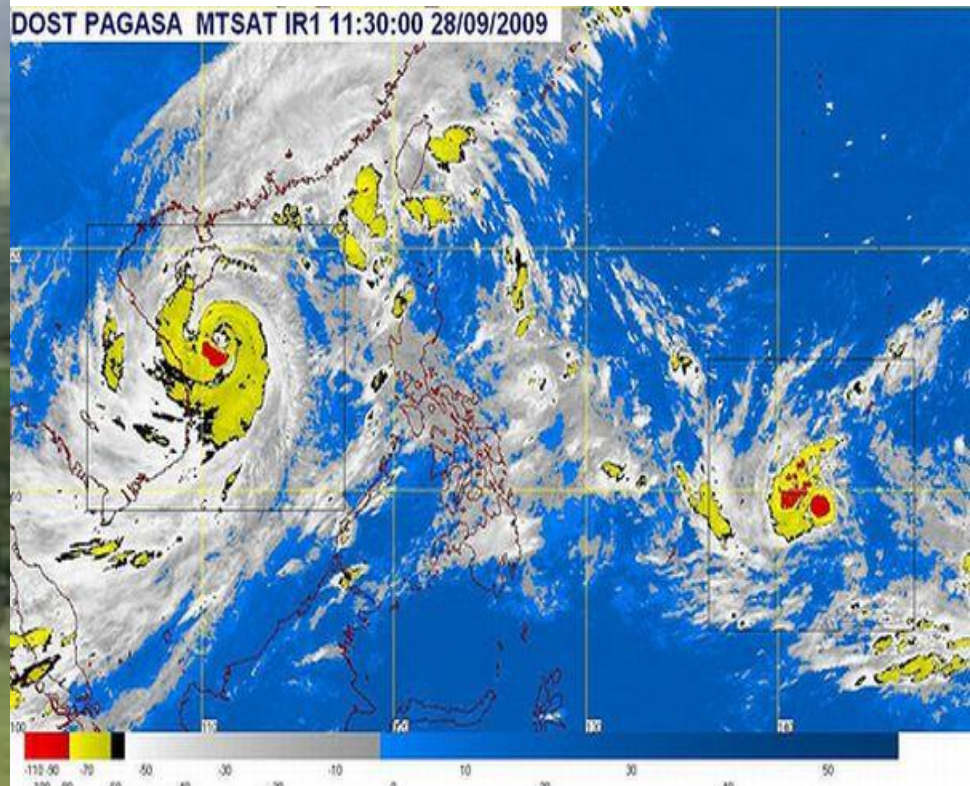

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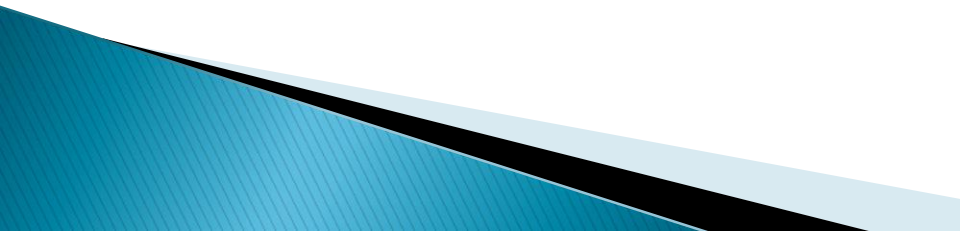


The climate is **changing!**

Weather

Weather is what happens outdoors everyday. We describe weather in terms of temperature (“it’s cold, or it’s hot outside”), precipitation (“it’s raining”), wind, humidity, cloudiness, air pressure, and other factors.



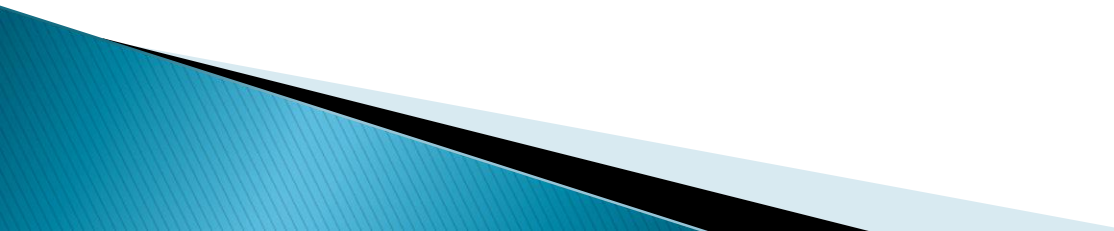


Climate

- Climate is the average weather over a long period, ranging from months to thousands of years. The average daily weather pattern in the Philippines is categorized as dry or wet.
- When the climate changes, the average weather also changes. For example, summer season may become hotter and rainy season may become wetter.

What is Climate Change?

❖ refers to a change in climate that can be identified by changes in the mean and/ or variability of its properties and that persists for an extended period typically decades or longer, whether, due to natural variability or as a result of human activity.

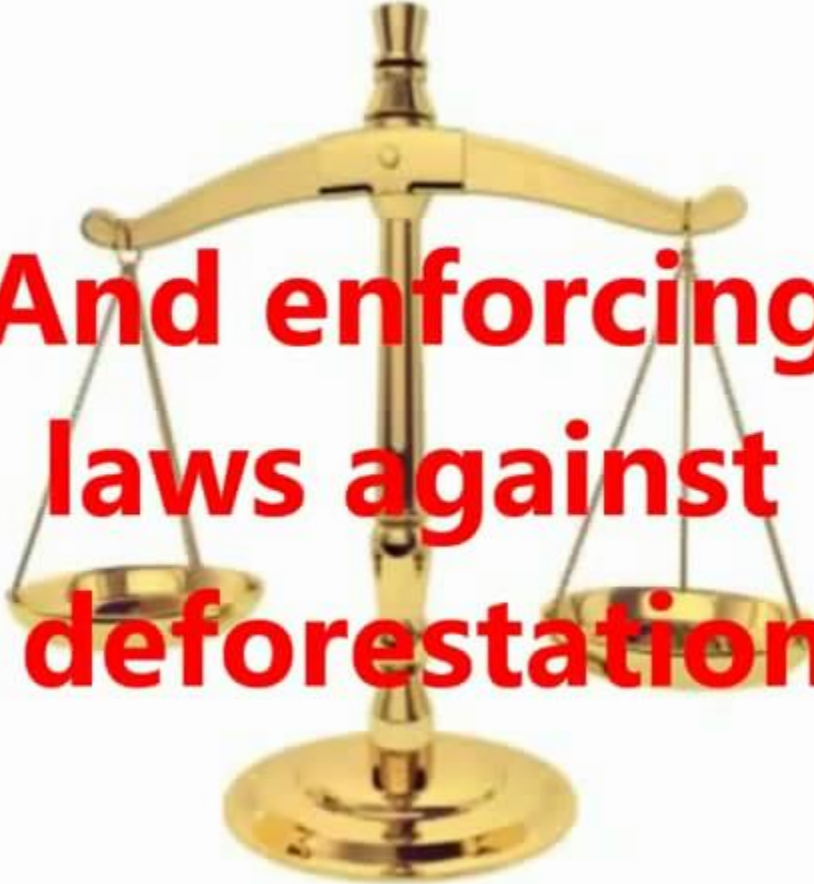
